

Cell Phone Policy

YRC Transportation Cell Phone Policy

The use of any cell phone, with or without a hands-free device, is not permitted while physically operating any company owned or leased vehicle, without the operator first pulling off to a safe location or being legally parked. The operator may use his/her cell phone in an emergency situation, by again pulling off to a safe location or being legally parked, for the immediate notification of an accident, injury, breakdown or any other emergency.

Where Nextel phones, handheld two-way radios, or any other devices are used for communication with drivers on duty, the following will apply:

The phone, radio, or communication device is not to be used while the vehicle is being operated in traffic. It is the responsibility of the driver to pull off to a safe location or be properly parked before carrying on the needed conversation.

Drivers must not make any modification(s) to the phone, phone settings, software on the phone or the related "direct connect" numbers and address book.

Drivers must not attempt to intentionally interfere with phone transmissions in any way.

Drivers must leave the phones powered on during their entire work shift.

Any unauthorized changes may result in disciplinary action being taken. This includes possible termination of employment.
