Our contract requires UPS to maintain 20,000 full-time combo jobs nationally.

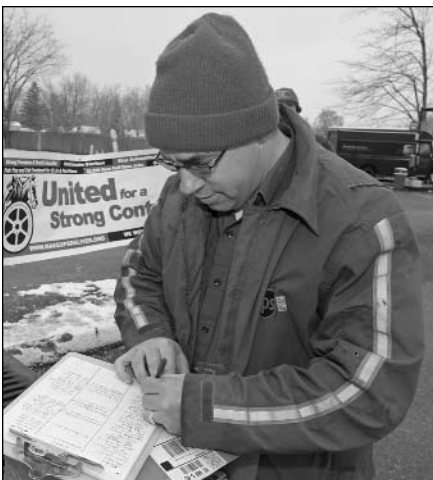
The company is thousands of full-time jobs short of the 20,000 required—and management is eliminating more full-time combo jobs every day.
